Juniors: 4-H age 9 - 13

12 arrows at 30 meters; 12 arrows at 20 meters

Seniors: 4-H age 14 - 18

12 arrows at 40 meters; 12 arrows at 30 meters

### Minimum qualifying scores:

Recurve Barebow 100/240 points

Recurve Olympic 140/240 points

Compound - Bow Hunter 200/240 points

Compound - Open 210/240 points

Individual Awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each class
