Time limit: 4 minutes per 6 arrow

Juniors: 4-H age 9-13      12 arrows at 30 meters; 12 arrows at 20 meters

Seniors: 4-H age 14-18      12 arrows at 40 meters; 12 arrows at 30 meters

### Minimum qualifying scores

Recurve- Barebow	100 points	Compound-Bow Hunter	200 points
Recurve- Olympic	140 points	Compound- Open	210 points

Individual awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each class.
