#### Check-In

4-H Poultry check-in is Friday, September 6 from 4:00-7:00 p.m. Enter at Gate 10 (located Plum Street) and let the gate staff know you are here to drop off your 4-H Poultry exhibit(s). You should receive a slip of paper that allows you to enter and drop off your exhibit. You will need a gate admission ticket.

#### **Health Requirements**

- Chickens/turkeys that have been P/T tested within 90 days of the Kansas
  State Fair should provide the P/T testing certificate at check-in
- All chickens and turkeys not P/T tested at their local fair will be tested at check-in.

### **Judging Day**

• Judging will take place Saturday, September 6 beginning at 1:00 p.m. 4-H'ers may be present during judging, but are not required to do so.

## **Poultry Exhibit Release**

- All 4-H Poultry will be released from at 3:30 7:00 p.m. the last Sunday of the fair. Cages must be vacated by 7:00 p.m.
- Enter at gate #10 on Plum Street and get a delivery release hang tag. You will not need a gate ticket at gate #10 to pick up animals.
- You may need to park in the purple lot behind the livestock barns and walk in to the poultry barn with crates and/or cages.
- Please note that all other 4-H exhibits in 4-H Centennial Hall will not be released until 6:00 p.m.
